Treatment Of Donkeys

Peaceful Valley Employees, Contractor, Volunteers, Veterinarians and Affiliates will never strike, kick, pull on ears or the tails of any donkeys in a violent manner. Doing so will result in that person's immediate removal from Peaceful Valley property and termination of service.

This applies to PVDR staff and any vendor (or volunteer) that handles PVDR donkeys, including vets, farriers, equine dentists, contract WBP captures, etc.

PVDR will not tolerate rough handling of our donkeys. This includes:

- No ear twitching (twisting)
- No lip twitching
- No pulling/twisting tails
- No hog tying (except as a safety restraint if needed to safely move a donkey on a sled/drag)
- No ropes around necks so that it creates an asphyxiation hazard
- Hitting with any object with intent to harm, beat into submission. Use of rattle paddles with light tapping on legs is okay when needed to direct/move animals)
- No use of cattle prods
